Why Support Military Families?

Military families and their children are among the most transient populations; on average, military youth move six to nine times between kindergarten and high school graduation. This high level of mobility can disrupt friendships, extracurricular activities, and community engagement, often adding stress to their academic, emotional, and social lives. Nearly 2 million children have a parent serving in the U.S. military.
